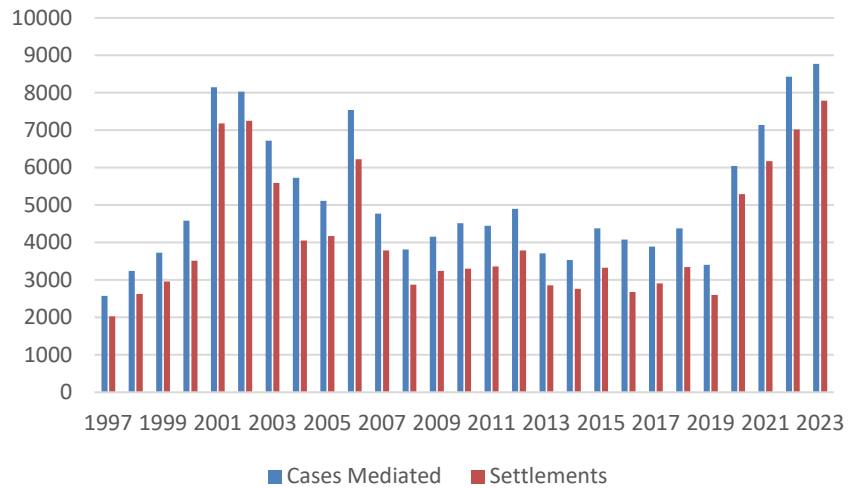

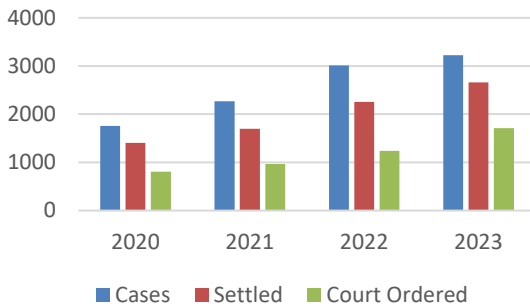

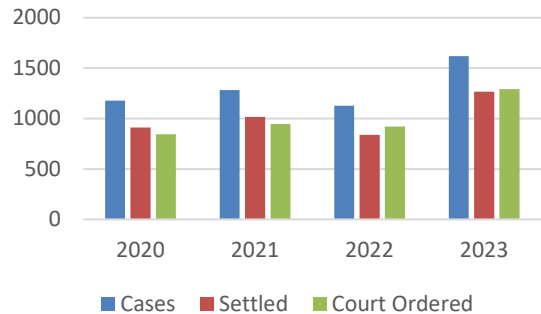

Civil Mediation Non-Divorce



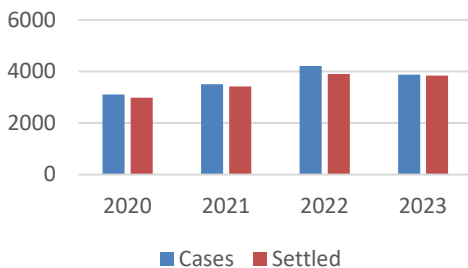

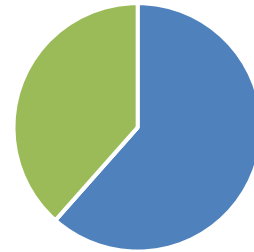

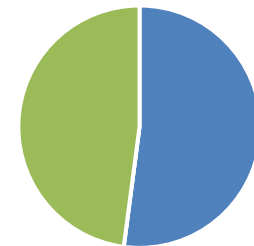

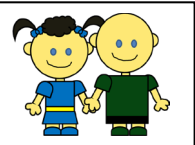
ALABAMA COURT OF CIVIL APPEALS
