4	ENROLLED, An Act,
5	Relating to the appointment of private judges; to
6	amend Sections 12-11A-2 and 12-11A-4, Code of Alabama 1975, to
7	allow former and retired probate judges meeting specified
8	requirements to serve as private judges in certain cases.
9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
10	Section 1. Sections 12-11A-2 and 12-11A-4 of the
11	Code of Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:
12	"§12-11A-2.
13	"(a) Persons who may act as private judges shall:
14	"(1) Have been, but are not actively serving as, a
15	judge of a district, or circuit, or probate court and have
16	served in the capacity of judge for at least six consecutive
17	years.
18	"(2) Be admitted to the practice of law in Alabama.
19	"(3) Be an active member in good standing of the
20	Alabama State Bar Association.
21	"(4) Be a resident of Alabama.
22	"(b) A person may act as a judge of a case under
23	this chapter only if all of the following occur:
24	"(1) All parties to the action file a written
2 =	notition with the giravit glark of the court in which the

1	action is pending requesting a private judge and naming the
2	person whom the parties wish to have as private judge. The
3	petition shall be accompanied by a form signed by the private
4	judge selected consenting to the appointment.
5	"(2) The case is one over which the court in which
6	the former judge served would have had subject matter and
7	monetary jurisdiction.
8	"(3) The case is founded exclusively on domestic
9	relations, contract, tort, or a combination of contract and
10	tort assigned a CV or DR case number by the Alabama
11	Administrative Office of Courts.
12	"§12-11A-4.
13	"(a) A trial conducted by a private judge shall be
14	conducted without a jury.
15	"(b) A person who serves as a private judge has, for
16	each case the private judge hears, the same powers as the
17	judge of a circuit court in relation to the following:
18	"(1) Court procedure.
19	"(2) Deciding the outcome of the case.
20	"(3) Attendance of witnesses.
21	"(4) Punishment of contempt.
22	"(5) Enforcement of orders.
23	"(6) Administering oaths.
24	"(7) Giving all necessary certificates for the
25	authentication of the records and proceedings.

1	"(c) A person appointed as a private judge pursuant
2	to the terms of this chapter shall have immunity in the same
3	manner and to the same extent as a judge in the State of
4	Alabama.

- "(d) All proceedings in an action heard by a private
 judge are of record and must be:
- 7 "(1) Filed with the clerk of the circuit court in 8 the county of proper venue under the Alabama Rules of Civil 9 Procedure.
- "(2) Made available to the public in the same manner
 as circuit court records.

"(e) The Alabama Rules of Civil Procedure shall apply for all actions brought before a private judge. The private judge shall maintain jurisdiction over all matters brought before him or her until the order is deemed final and appealable, as defined by the Alabama Rules of Civil Procedure to the same extent as matters before a trial court, including all post-trial proceedings and subsequent proceedings between the same parties arising from the same case. An appeal from an action or a judgment of a private judge may be taken in the same manner as an appeal from the circuit court of the county where the case is filed."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
